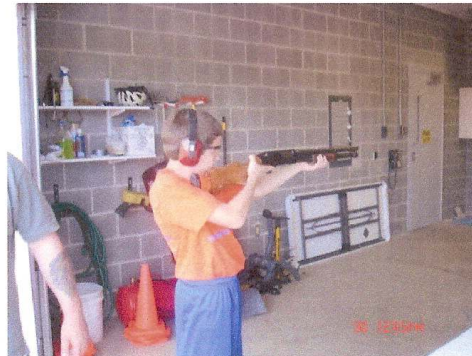
COP'S & KID'S

To be eligible for consideration to the Jr. Police Academy a boy or girl must be at least 12 years old but not older than 15 by July 1, 2006. He or she must be a resident of either Plainfield Township, Pen Argyl or Wind Gap Boroughs and must be in good physical condition. He or she must also have a grade C average and good school discipline record.

Interested boys and girls must submit applications no later than May 29, 2007. After this date names will be picked in according to the date received. Additional applications can be picked up at the Plainfield Township Police Headquarters or the Wind Gap Middle School.
